She obtained a medical license in 1983, and received her Ph.D. from Tokyo Women's Medical University in 1991. She was awarded several honors and scientific prized, including the awards of Yoshioka Yayoi in 1999. She has been Chairperson of scientific committee of diabetes-related index in Japan Society of Clinical Chemistry, and corresponding member of the Committee on the Education in the Use of Biomarkers in Diabetes (C-EUBD) in IFCC. Her research interests have focused on studies of biomarker of blood glucose metabolism in the field of clinical chemistry, and cardiac left ventricular structure and function in the fields of diabetology.
