He is currently a Representative Director of the Green Cross Genome in Korea, which is a leading company providing clinical genomic tests using next-generation sequencing and cutting-edge molecular technologies. He received his MD from Seoul National University and PhD from Sungkyunkwan University in Korea. After receiving a residency in Laboratory Medicine at Samsung Medical Center, he has been a professor at the same hospital from Mar 2005 to May 2018. He published more than 180 papers in the field of molecular diagnostics as a first or corresponding author, and was awarded a number of honors and scientific prizes. His research interests have focused on studies of the molecular diagnostics of Mendelian disorders, especially neurodegenerative and cardiovascular diseases. He is also interested in the development and evaluation of molecular diagnostic technologies. More recently he concentrated on the genomic diagnostics.
