Dr. Wah Wah Aung is presently serving as the Director (Research) of the Department of Medical Research (DMR), Ministry of Health and Sports, situated in Yangon, Myanmar. She received her MBBS (Bachelor of Medicine & Bachelor of Surgery) degree from Institute of Medicine (1), Yangon, Myanmar in 1990. She also received MMedSc (Microbiology) (Master in Medical Science, Microbiology) and Ph. D degrees from University of Medicine (1), Yangon, Myanmar in 1998 and 2008 respectively. She had joined the civil service in Myanmar since 1993 and spent one year in clinical disciplines and then she joined DMR in 1994. Since then she devoted her career as medical researcher/microbiologist and she also served as part-time consultant microbiologist in private clinics and hospitals. Her major fields of interest are bacteriology, molecular diagnostics, molecular epidemiology and genetic research.
